

Delaware Valley University is currently seeking candidates for **Manager of Crop Production – (051117/1120/14)** – This is a full-time exempt position in our Crop Production/Plant Science/School of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences Department and is based upon a 50-hour work week in the summer and a 40-hour week in the winter. Responsibilities include but are not limited to management of 400 acres of grain and forage production, student employees, interns, budgeting, and working with faculty to coordinate educational and classroom needs. The candidate is also responsible for general maintenance and repair of the agriculture equipment, and field & maintenance records. The manager collaborates with other university farm units - including livestock, dairy, equine, horticulture, and faculty to make decisions regarding crop selection, locations, and logistics with a priority on producing the best possible forages and grains in an educational setting. During the growing season an alternative schedule may be required.
