



October 4, 2013 -- The Maryland Farm Bureau (MFB) would like to inform farmers throughout the state of upcoming farm tire drop-off events. These events provide farmers with an opportunity to drop-off unwanted tires at local landfills and other locations without having to access a special permit or pay a fee. Each county has set different criteria on the amount and type of tires that may be delivered. Event dates and county contact information are available in the chart below. Citizen Scrap Tire Drop-off Days are sponsored by local governments, the Maryland Department of the Environment and Maryland Environmental Service.

The counties that already held tire collection events are: Carroll, Charles, Frederick, Garrett, Howard, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, St. Mary's, Wicomico, and Worcester.
