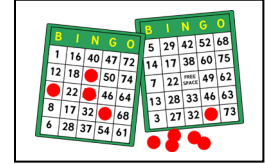

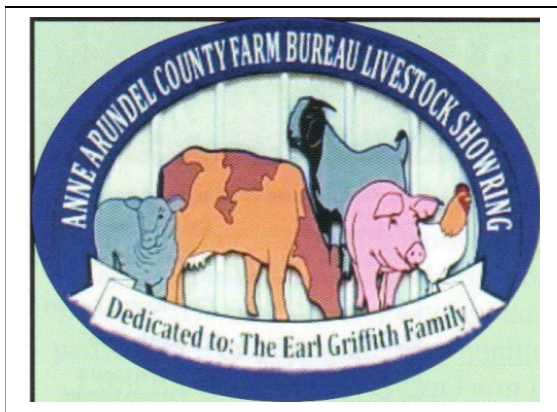

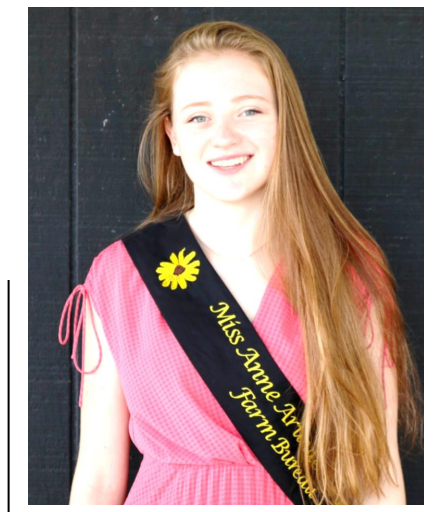
During their picnic at the show ring, AACFB held a ribbon cutting ceremony, assisted by
