- 5. Applicant must receive two excellent letters of recommendation from a teacher/instructor and an employer, mentor, coach, club advisor or religious leader.
- 6. Applicant must provide response to essay prompt of 500 words or less.
- 7. Applicant must be available to receive the scholarship in person at the Montgomery County Farm Bureau June Picnic or a monthly Board of Directors meeting. *Please Note: With the current COVID-19 crisis, the June Farm Bureau picnic will potentially change to a later month in the year.
