Eligibility:

- 1. Applicants must be a resident of Montgomery County, Maryland.
- 2. All applicants or their parent/guardians must be members, in good standing, of the Montgomery County Farm Bureau to be eligible to apply. *Maryland Farm Bureau Student Only members are no longer eligible for this scholarship. - 3. Applicants must be a current high school senior with plans to start college in the Fall semester of 2024, or applicants must be a current full-time student at any accredited vocational, community college, or four-year institution.
- 4. Applicants must demonstrate an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 5. Applicants must receive one letter of recommendation: from a teacher/instructor in the area of your major and/or from your employer, mentor, coach, club advisor, or religious leader.
- 6. Applicants must provide an answer to the provided essay question of 500 words or less.

7. Applicants must be available to receive the scholarship at our Montgomery County Farm Bureau June picnic. If unable to attend the June picnic, applicants are expected to visit the Board of Directors at their MCFB Board of Directors monthly meeting. The 2024 June picnic is scheduled for Sunday, June 9th at 4 PM at Laytonsville Turf Farm. Laytonsville Turf Farm is located at 5225 Damascus Road, Laytonsville, Maryland 20882. The MCFB Board of Directors meetings tentatively meet the first Tuesday of every month at 7 PM at the Montgomery County Agricultural History Farm Park.
