## CAROLINE COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP

1. \$1000 Scholarships are available to students who are Caroline County Farm Bureau members or whose parents are CCFB members, who are graduating high school seniors or presently a full-time college undergraduate at a 2 or 4 year college. A student can only win once but may apply more than once.
2. The Caroline County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee will screen applications and make the final selection. Applicant deadline is March 28, 2025.
3. The Scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving individuals and income is not a factor. The selection will be made using the following criteria, which is listed beginning with the highest priority. **The applicant must be a member or the child of a CCFB member.**
  - \*Pursuing Agriculture-related degree
  - \*Agriculture Background
  - \*Farm Bureau involvement
  - \*FFA/4H Involvement
  - \*Academics
  - \*Community and Social involvement
  - \*Child of a Farm Bureau member
4. Scholarship winners will be recognized at the CCFB picnic on July 10, 2025, and attendance is required (no exceptions). Payment will be made to the recipient upon completion of the fall 2025 semester and 2.0 minimum gpa is verified by the scholarship committee chairman.
